Eligibility: To participate, you must meet the following criteria:

1. Between the ages of 18 and 74
2. Genetic confirmation of SCA2 or SCA 3
3. Have symptoms related to ataxia
4. Do not require assistive walking device
5. Participating or willing to participate in the CRC-SCA natural history study
6. Fluent English speaker
7. Reachable by phone and/or video calls
